WE ARE GOING CASHLESS!

After October 23rd 2020, we will no longer be able to accept any cash payments into school.

After this date, all payments MUST be done online via the parent payment portal.

We are aware some of you have struggled to work the app. If this is the case, please make us aware in the office and we will look into it for you. The main issue so far seems to be incorrect or absent email addresses on our system. Please ensure this information is correct with the office.

New school snack with Mellors

We have been piloting the new snack system for all pupils and we are glad to say it has proven very popular! To enable us to continue to offer this service we will need to make some adjustments to payment methods with immediate effect, as follows:

- All payments need to be made by 10am on the Friday, for your payment to be registered for the following week's snack via Mellors.
- If we receive payment after this time, you will need to provide your child with a snack from home for the following week and they will be on the register to receive snack via Mellors the week after that.
- As already mentioned - we are going to be cashless after the October half term, so we would encourage you to pay for snack online now and if you experience any trouble doing this, it will give us time to look into this for you. But we are still able to accept cash for the time being.

Be smart and stay safe - please wear a mask!
