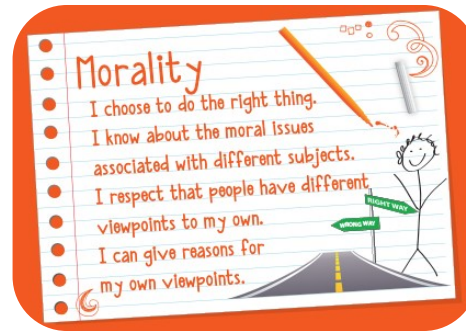

You will have received an email regarding parents evening this term being completed via a phone call due to not being able to invite parents into the school for a face to face meeting

We understand this is not ideal and causes a potential inconvenience to some families, it also means our teachers are on a tighter schedule than normal, please bare with us and understand we **will** be in touch and we **want** to feedback about your child's progress.

Don't forget to log into Arbor!

If you are experiencing trouble getting



onto your account, or understanding how to use the app please call the school office to arrange an appointment with us, we can go through the log in process with you on a school laptop and show you how to make payments. This should only require 5-10 minutes of your time.

TOP TIP: Please be aware if you are paying for snack - this can be found under the heading activities - select 'clubs' - and then select 'snack'. You will need to select the weeks you wish your child to receive snack and make payment here.

Payments made under meals will not add your child's name to the snack register.

May we remind you after the half term we are to become a 'cashless' school, which means **all** payments for example lunch, snack, uniforms etc will need to be made online and we will not be able to accept any cash for these items.
